<b>BEFORE ARRIVAL</b>					
Symptoms of COVID-19	Everyone	Red	Anyone attending should self screen prior to arrival. Anyone displaying symptoms should remain at home and follow government guidance.	Green	
Travel	Everyone	Red	Where possible, players, coaches and officials should make their own way to the ground. Those sharing lifts should wear masks and should lower car windows.	Yellow	
<b>ON ARRIVAL</b>					
Personal Hygiene	Everyone	Yellow	All to sanitise their hands on arrival.	Green	
Test and Trace	COVID-19 Officer and Club Officials	Red	The details of all players, coaches and officials shall be recorded for test and trace purposes. Where possible the visiting team should provide a complete list of their travelling party to ease this process. Details will be kept for 21 days and then disposed of in accordance with GDPR guidelines. If anyone in attendance develops symptoms prior to the game, the COVID-19 officer shall contact	Green	

			all attendees and ask them to self-isolate and register for a test.		
<b>Venue Navigation</b>	Newent School		A one-way system will be in place at the venue.		
<b>PRE-MATCH</b>					
<b>Cleaning of venue equipment</b>	Club officials		All equipment including goalposts, corner flags to be cleaned prior to kick off, at half time and following match.		
<b>Cleaning of match equipment</b>	Club officials		All match equipment such as match balls to be cleaned prior to kick off, at half time and following match.		
<b>Use of changing rooms</b>	Club officials, players and match officials		Changing rooms to be out of use prior to match. Players and officials should turn up in kit.		
<b>Toilets</b>	Newent School		Toilets to be available pre-match, during the game and for 30-minutes after the game.		
<b>Match Fees</b>	Club officials		Match fees of £30 to be handed to referee in a sealed envelope prior to kick off. The £30 shall be made up of notes only – no coins.		
<b>DURING MATCH</b>					
<b>Drinks bottles</b>	Players		Players to bring their own drinks bottles. Bottles are not to be shared		
<b>Ball out of play</b>	Club officials		The ball will only be retrieved by a club official or a player, preferably using only their feet		
<b>Spitting and shouting</b>	Everyone		Spitting and shouting should be refrained upon wherever possible due to the greater risk of virus transmission. Players should avoid shouting when directly facing another player.		
<b>Referee interactions</b>	Players and match officials		Players and match officials should ensure they maintain social distancing during interactions with each other		
<b>Goal celebrations</b>	Players		Goal celebrations are to be avoided.		
<b>Spectators</b>	Club officials		Any spectators should be encouraged to socially distance and should not be in groups of more than six.		
<b>First Aid</b>	Club officials		Only serious injuries will be treated. The official carrying out the treatment should wear a mask and gloves.		

<b>Linesman Flags</b>	Club officials		Club to provide own linesman flag to assist match officials. Flag shall be cleaned upon any handover.		
<b>Pitch-Side</b>	Everyone		Those pitch-side during a game should observe social distancing.		
<b>POST-MATCH</b>					
<b>Sanitising</b>	Everyone		Everyone to sanitise their hands as soon as possible following the game. Equipment should be wiped down as soon as possible.		
<b>Washing/Showers</b>	Newent School		Showers to be closed and unavailable for use until guidance changes.		
<b>Leaving the Ground</b>	Everyone		Attendees should not gather following the match and should leave the ground promptly.		
<b>Kit Washing</b>	Club officials and players		Players will wash their own shorts and socks. A nominated club official shall wash the shirts, taking care to sanitise before and after washing.		
<b>Infected player/official</b>	Everyon		Anyone who tests positive following the match should report it to the COVID-19 officer who will initiate the Test and Trace procedure.
