


<b>Before activity</b>					
Symptoms of COVID-19	Everyone		<p>Everyone attending the ground, must complete our self-screen check <b>BEFORE</b> arrival to the ground.</p> <p>If they have <b>ANY</b> of symptoms, they should stay home and follow the latest government guidance.</p>		

<b>Player/Coach developing COVID-19</b>	Everyone		<p>Appointed a COVID-19 officer who has completed a risk assessment before re-starting activity.</p> <p>Before all training and matches, players must notify COVID-19 officer via club what's-app group, list is compiled and saved in line with the date, this will be kept in accordance with GDPR and shredded after 21 days.</p> <p>Any new players who arrive at training, must complete our track and trace form. If anyone in attendance develops COVID-19 symptoms, the COVID-19 officer will contact everyone in attendance to inform them to self-isolate and get an NHS test.</p>		
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<b>Personal Hygiene</b>	Everyone		All players/ coaches to sanitise their hands prior to training/matchday, on arrival and in any breaks of play.		
<b>Cleaning of equipment</b>	Covid-19 Officer and club members		All equipment, corner flags and goal posts to be cleaned before matches, at half time and the end of any session.		
<b>Travel</b>	Everyone		Players are to travel to and from training/matches solo where possible.  If lift sharing is required, driver and all passengers must wear facemasks with		
<b>Use of changing rooms</b>	Managers, players and officials.		Changing room access permitted with facemasks and social distancing.  If changing room is too small to fit all players from one team in and social distancing cannot be maintained, changing must be split into groups.		
<b>Meet up times</b>	Managers, players and officials		Staggered arrival times for players and the officials to ease the congestion and risk of “bumping into each other” COVID-19 Officer will contact the away team and officials to confirm the arrival.  Example 2pm KO Home Team arrive at 12:45pm Away Team arrive at 13:00pm		

<b>Arrival</b>	Covid-19 officer and club members		A one-way system will be set up to avoid any unnecessary contact.		
<b>Toilets</b>	Everyone		Temperature scanned on arrival to Toilets in changing rooms. Social distancing maintained. Cleaned thoroughly.		
<b>During training/match play</b>					
<b>Outdoor training group size</b>	Managers and players		Players to contact managers before arrival via club what's-app so that manager/coach can plan effectively. Managers to separate training groups to ensure there are not any groups larger than 30 (including managers and coaches)		
<b>Sanitising</b>	Everyone		COVID-19 officer to follow guidance of officials and leagues regarding sanitizing break of goal posts, corner flags and equipment.		
<b>Drink bottles</b>	Players		Players needs to bring their own labelled water bottle training and matches. There will be no sharing of bottles.		
<b>Ball Out of play</b>	Club members		If the ball goes of play, it will be retrieved by a member of the club at the game that day, they will retrieve the ball using their feet where possible.		
<b>Spitting, shouting, chewing gum</b>	Everyone		Players and officials should not spit when training or on a matchday. Any chewing gum must be disposed of <b>BEFORE</b> entry to the ground and		

<b>Goal celebrations</b>	Players		Close proximity goal celebrations are to be discouraged. No hugging		
<b>Spectators</b>	Club members		Spectators will be reminded to maintain social distancing by club signage around the pitch. If spectators do not adhere to social distancing, referee will stop the game.		
<b>First Aid</b>	Club members		Facemasks and gloves required for any individual who enters the field of play to administer first aid.		
<b>Match fees</b>	Secretary		Players to pay for their match fees using bank transfer to club account,		
<b>Pitchside</b>	Everyone		Social distancing to be maintained by all managers/coaches, substitutes, club members and spectators and all times.		
<b>After Activity</b>					
<b>Sanitising</b>	Everyone		Hands to be sanitised at the earliest opportunity after the match. Equipment will be wiped down by COVID Officer and club members.		
<b>Washing</b>	Players		Maximum shower capacity so that social distancing can be maintained. Players have individual home shirts; these are to be kept and cleaned by the player		
<b>Leaving the pitch and centre</b>	Everyone		Staggered departure times in the following order: Officials, Away team & then Home team.		

<b>Infected Player/Official</b>	Everyone		Anyone who becomes infected after the training session/activity should report it to the COVID-19 Officer, who will then contact everyone on the Track and Trace register.		
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
