If anyone in attendance develops COVID-19 symptoms, the COVID-19 officer will contact everyone in attendance to inform them to self-isolate and get an NHS test completed.		
Personal hygiene	Everyone		All players/ coaches to sanitise their hands on arrival at the sign in point. Hand sanitisers are in place on entrance to clubhouse, all toilets and social distance measures and cleaning materials are in place with a guide of "how to

Cleaning of equipment	COVID-19 officer and Team managers		All equipment, corner flags and goal posts to be cleaned before matches, and the end of any session.		
Travel	Everyone		Players to travel to sessions and matches individually or in their individual bubbles. Sharing of lifts is prohibited, until the change in Government guidance. If in groups of 4, the use of masks have advised.		
Use of changing rooms	Managers, players and officials.		Managers to hand out kit before the day of the match. Players and officials, to arrive at the game ready to play for away games and leave immediately after. Players are responsible for the washing of their own kit. Home team will have the use of BOTH changing rooms to change, changing rooms have been marked off into 1m areas to ensure social distancing.		
Arrival	COVID officer and committee		Home team to meet approx. 1hr 15mins before kick off to ensure small group changing.		
Toilets	Everyone		2x Toilets will be open for use and have all the hygiene measures and guidance in place.

Outdoor training group size	Managers and players		Players to contact managers via whatsapp group message before arrival, so that managers can play effectively. Managers to separate training groups to ensure there are not any groups larger than 30		
Drinks break	Everyone		COVID-19 officer to follow guidance of officials and leagues regarding drinks breaks to discourage spitting (Possibly every 22.5 minutes)		
Drink bottles	Players		Players need to bring their own labelled water bottle to training and matches. There will be no sharing of bottles.		
Ball out of play	Committee members		If the ball goes of play, it will be retrieved by a member of the committee at the game that day. They will retrieve the ball using their feet where possible.		
Goal celebrations	Players		Close goal celebrations are to be discouraged by management committee.		
Spectators	Committee		Area of field to be marked out for official spectators. ALL must sign the register and be aware of GDPR and the track and trace system. Any dog walkers watching from outside coned area will be asked to sign register.		
First aid	frst aiders		Only serious first aid injuries to be treated. team physio will be wearing a mask, gloves and apron available treating players.		
Match fees	Treasurer		Players to pay for their match fees using contactless payment.

Sanitising	Everyone		Hands to be sanitised at the earliest opportunity after the match. Equipment will be wiped down by COVID officer and committee.		
Washing	Players		Players to take the kit home and wash it themselves. Players to shower at home.
