Sanitising	Everyone		Players, Managers and Officials will be required to sanitise their hands at the first available opportunity.		
Showers	Players/Coaching staff		Following strict social distancing. No more than 2 persons in the shower area at any time and regular cleaning of shower area.		
Washing	Players/Covid-19 Officer		All players to leave kits in one designated area. This to be collected by a designated committee member in a sanitary manner and washed.		
Leaving the ground	Everyone		As per arrival.		
Infected player/official	Everyone		Anyone who become infected after the training session/ activity should report it to the COVID officer, who will then contact everyone on the Track and trace register.
